Towards a Situation Analysis

A situational analysis is a piece of pro-active research - it involves identifying your community and stakeholders and including them from the start, so that policies and activities are created in response to their needs.

As a first step reflect and make notes about your initiative and theory of change under the following headings

PEOPLE - who is it you want to engage with?

NEED - what is it they require or are struggling with?

RESOURCES - what resources will be required?

DIMENSIONS - are there any unique dimensions or challenges for this group?

HAVE YOU SPOKEN TO THEM? - have you tested your assumptions
