Minimum temperature: 1.5°C

Relative Humidity at midday: 96%

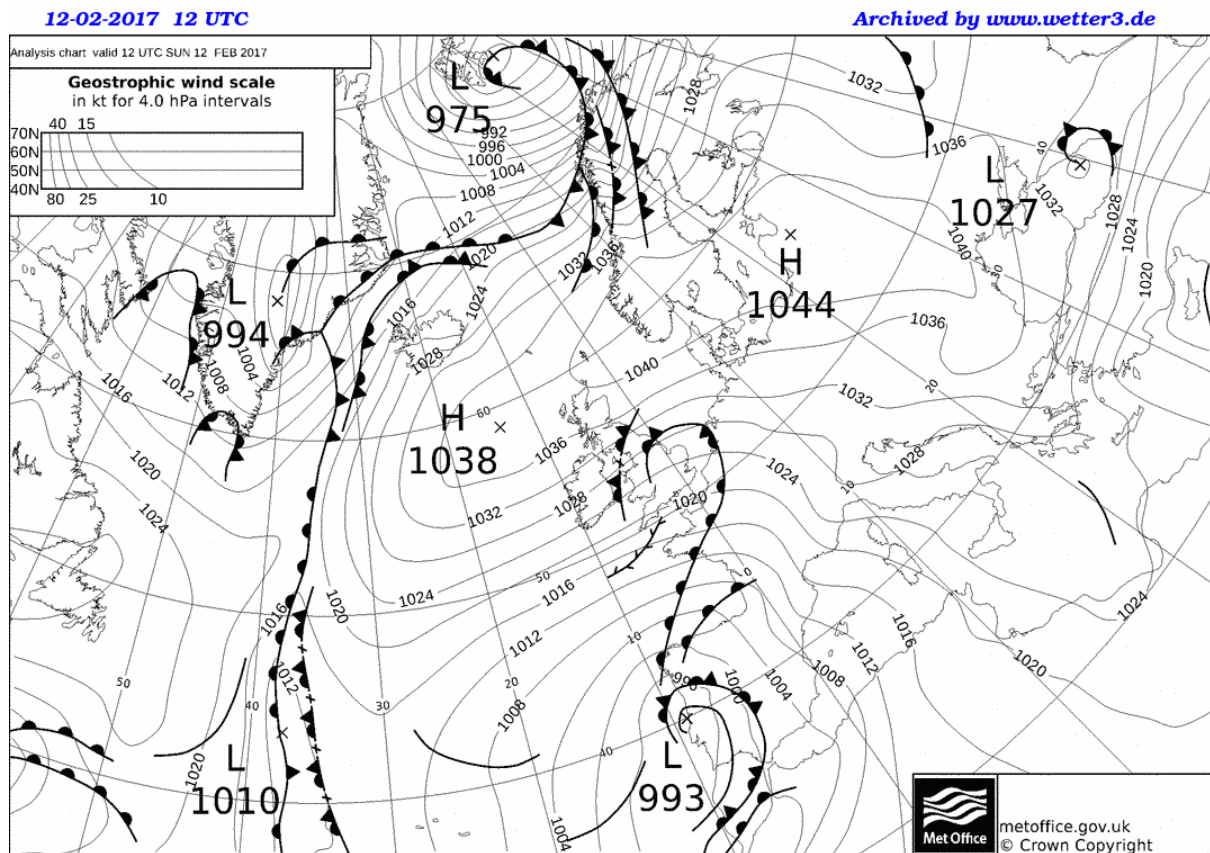
Many people did very well again, getting a score of 10 or more for their forecast. The maximum possible score is 16.

Although the air flow was dominated by the High pressure systems, giving easterly air flow over the UK, a couple of occluded fronts and a warm front which moved in later in the day gave cloud cover and some drizzle.
