Baby

Infants age <6 months receive TEO

Child

Children age ≥6 months and <7 years receive POS*

25 ml	>138
19 ml	>130-138
16 ml	>122-130
14 ml	>110-122
12 ml	>98-110
10 ml	>87-98
8 ml	>76-87
6 ml	>65-76
4 ml	>54-65
2 ml	>50-54




Powder for Oral Suspension (POS)

Adolescent

Children age ≥7 years and <15 years receive tablets


Tablets	Height (cm)
4 tablets	>138
3 tablets	>130-138



Tablets

Adult

People age ≥15 years receive 4 tablets



Tablets

*Note: Even if the individual is older than 7 years and tall enough to be given a tablet, if there is any concern that they may have trouble swallowing a tablet, POS should be provided.
