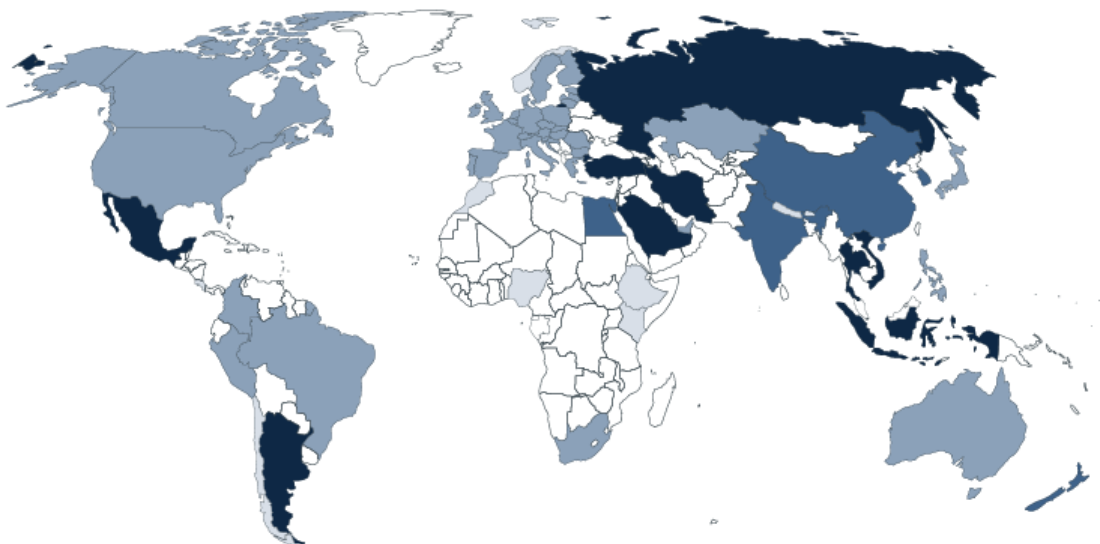
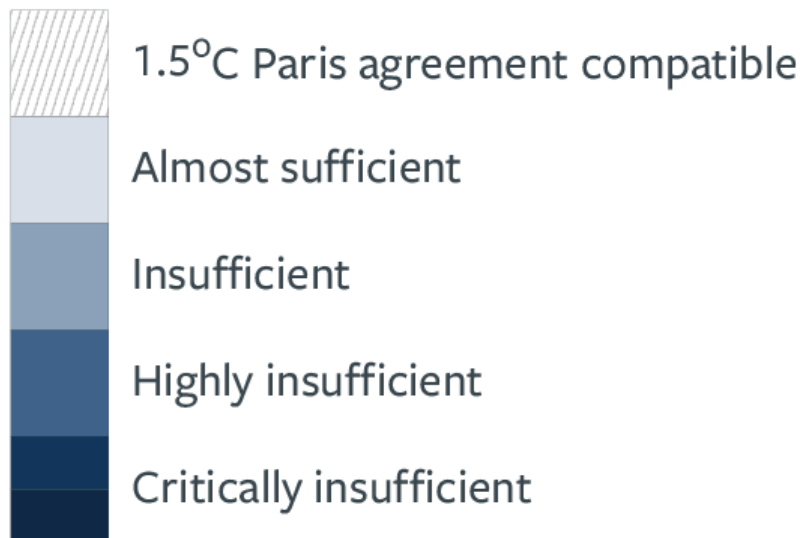


Image description

This world map illustrates how different countries' climate policies and commitments align with the 1.5°C target set by the Paris Agreement. Each country is shaded in one of five colours, corresponding to different levels of sufficiency.

Legend:

- White with diagonal lines belongs to 1.5°C Paris Agreement compatible.
- Light grey represents Almost sufficient.
- Medium grey indicates Insufficient.
- Dark blue pointed Highly insufficient.
- Deep navy blue presents Critically insufficient.
- Mexico, Argentina, Russia, and many countries in the Middle East, South and East Asia including Turkey, Iran, Saudi Arabia, India, China, Thailand, Vietnam, Indonesia are shaded in dark blue or deep navy blue, indicating highly insufficient or critically insufficient policies.
- North America, parts of South America, Australia, Many European countries and a few in Africa and Latin America appear in lighter shades, signifying better performance relative to the 1.5°C target.
- Very few countries are marked with white may belong no data available.
- Notably, no countries are marked as 1.5°C Paris Agreement compatible.
