Dr Yemisi Bolade-Ogunfodun is a Post-Doctoral Fellow in Managing People (MOOC) at Henley Business School, University of Reading and currently the Lead Educator on the Business School's Massive Open Online Course: Managing People: Understanding Individual Differences. She previously obtained a PhD in Management from the School's Department of Leadership Organisations and Behaviour. She has also previously held a Sessional Lectureship role. Her PhD research specialises in the theory of organisational culture from an anthropological perspective, focusing on organisational contexts of cultural diversity such as post-merger/acquisition contexts. Yemisi's research interests also cover meaning systems underpinning work practices, ethical implications of incongruence in meanings as well as ethnographic approaches to organisational research.

Prior to her PhD, Yemisi has also completed cross-disciplinary Bachelors and Masters degrees in Economics (BSc), Marketing (Master of Business Administration) and International Management (MSc). Yemisi has experience of working with a number of organisations in industry before

obtaining her PhD and joining Henley Business School. She has 10 years of work experience in commercial and retail banking within the financial services industry. She also has rich experience of initiating and managing stakeholder relationships with both public and private sector clients and managing people within organisations in her various management roles over the years.

Yemisi is part of the Centre for Social and Organisation Studies and contributes to teaching on both post-graduate and undergraduate programmes in the Business School covering a range of Organisational Behaviour modules such as: People and Organisations, Organisational Behaviour and Managing People and Organisations.
