



 Open Stop Motion Pro and select new movie icon. Make sure you are in Library view.



2. Tap on the camera icon to start taking your frames.



3. Tap on the icon in the top right hand corner to bring up camera options. Turn off auto white balance, auto exposure and auto focus.






4. Slide the toggle bar on the left hand side to turn on the onion skin function.



5. Make sure that the timer is set to **off** for manual capturing. To view your animation press the back arrow in the top left.



6. Tap on individual frames to bring up editing options. Some options will be locked on the free app.
When you are happy with your film press the back arrow to export your film.


