Relative contribution of each donor to the polio eradication effort

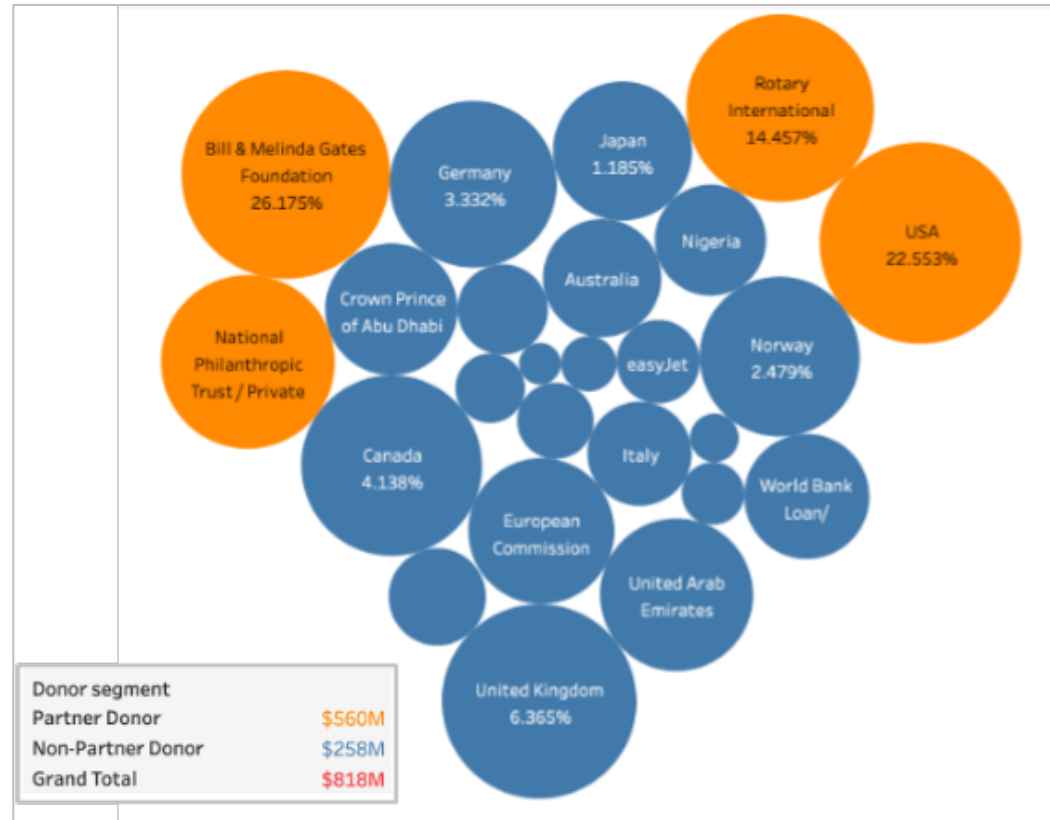
