

# WEATHER FORECAST SUMMARY

**How did do in the forecasting game? You can see the results here.**

The correct answers were:

Minimum temperature: 9.0°C

Maximum temperature: 15.9°C

Rainfall: 41.6mm

Relative Humidity at midday (UTC/ GMT): 94%

It was a really difficult day to forecast, and only a few people managed to get a positive score. The maximum possible score is 16 and the minimum is -16.

It rained extremely heavily in the morning in Reading, and the humidity was correspondingly high – these were the two areas where people tended to lose marks.

The image below shows the synoptic chart for midday on the 14<sup>th</sup>; it was the fronts associated with the remains of storm Callum and ex-hurricane Leslie that dictated the day's weather.

Don't be disheartened if you didn't get a good score – have another go this week! Hopefully a bit of experience will come together to give you a better score. If you like, you can leave making the forecast to Thursday or Friday, when the weather charts for Sunday will be available.
