- 3. **by this Friday** A good timeline. However, some people may want more information: any time before Friday, or by the end of the day, Friday?
- 4. **at your earliest convenience** Not a good timeline if you would like the reader to respond quickly. It's good to use when you're not in a hurry.
- 5. **by 10 January** A good timeline because it's very specific.
- 6. **by the end of this week** A good timeline. However, it could be more specific by saying which day.
- 7. **in due course** Not a good timeline because this phrase doesn't mention a deadline at all.
