Accessing Jupyter Notebook in Google Colab

Make sure you are using either Chrome, Firefox or Safari web browsers (it doesn't seem to work with Microsoft Edge).

1. Go to [Google Colab](#).

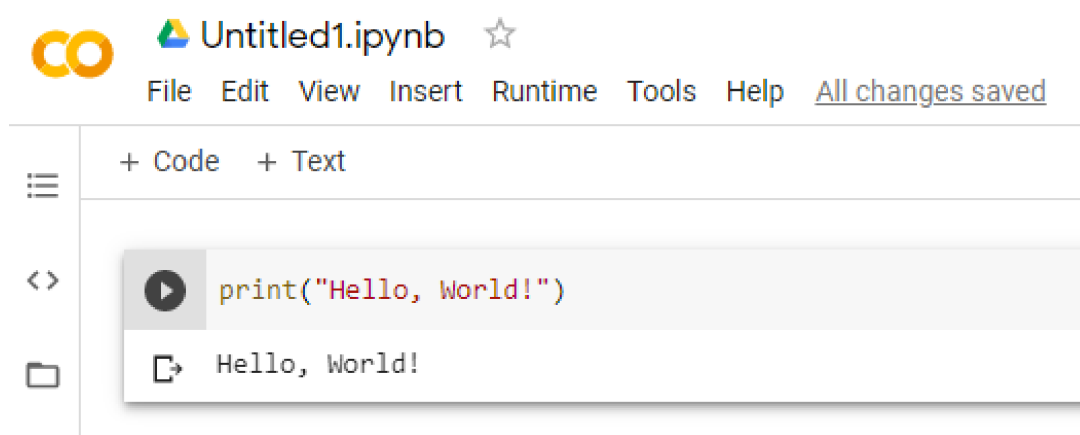
Note that you will need a Google account to log in and store your files on Google Drive.

2. Select **NEW NOTEBOOK** at the bottom of the popup window or go to the File Menu and select New notebook.

1. In the field next to the arrow enter: **print("Hello, World!")**

[Hello, World!](#) is a tradition in Computer Science as the first thing a student learns when learning a new programming language.

2. Select the arrow to the left of the field to run the Python code in that field. You should then see:



Now you are all set up with Jupyter Notebook hosted on Google Colab.
