



## WEATHER FORECAST GAME: WEEK 1 RESULTS

How did you do in the Forecasting Game in Week 1?

The correct answers were:

Minimum temperature: 13.9°C

Maximum temperature: 22.9°C

Rainfall: 0.4mm

Relative Humidity at midday (British Summer Time): 50%


Firstly, a massive apology – the results published last week were wrong and most people did significantly better. The updated results have been put on the week 1 forecasting article and you can also see them here. There were in fact some very high scores - the maximum possible score is 16. Again apologies, we should have noticed that an error had crept into the spreadsheet.

This week, Sunday's weather was complicated by a weak depression coming through in the morning, leaving polar maritime air in its wake.

On the whole, the observed values were very similar to last week – so I thought I'd look at the  $\underline{\text{Met Office}}$   $\underline{\text{website}}$  to compare these values with the 'climate' of Reading in June – the values of maximum and minimum temperature are 20.0°C and 10.6°C.

In week 3 you have one more opportunity to test your understanding by forecasting the weather for the  $9^{th}$  July.
