Joining the course as a group

Register for the course

1. Go to <https://www.futurelearn.com/courses/differentiating-for-learning-stem/4>
2. Click the **Join course** button at the top right. Then **Join free** (you can Upgrade later for extended access and to receive a certificate if you complete the course).
3. If you have a FutureLearn account, click the **Sign in** link at the top of the page, else register for FutureLearn using the form provided.

Post to the first course step and follow other learners

1. Once the course has started, go to the first course step at <https://www.futurelearn.com/courses/differentiating-for-learning-stem/4/steps/450887>
2. Share your professional development goal in the comments at the bottom of the page, then click **Post**.
3. For each person in your group, find a post they have made and click the **Follow** link at the top right of their post. The link will change to say: **Following**.

View recent posts just from your group

1. Once the course has started, go to the course content.
2. Click the **Activity** tab at the top of the week page.
3. Click the **Following** link.
4. Click **View conversation** on any post to access the full discussion and step.

View most recent 100 posts from an individual

1. Click on a learner's name in any FutureLearn comment or discussion post. This accesses their profile.
2. Scroll down, underneath the list of courses they are participating in you will see their most recent posts.

Important notes about registering for courses and access to courses
